Such were the questions thrown at school students during the Tata Consultancy Services' inter-school information and technology quiz — TCSITWiz 2014. Held at the Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya auditorium on Wednesday, six schools from

Indore and Bhopal battled out for the regional finals of the TCSITWiz.

Five teams from Indore and one from Bhopal qualified for the regional final round, after clearing the prelim round (consisting of a written test). The schools which qualified were: The Emerald Heights International School, Delhi Public School, St Arnold Higher Secondary School,

St Paul Higher Secondary School and Sagar Public School Bhopal (SPS).

Beating all the five, Aditya Nair and Ayush Songra from SPS, Bhopal, won the quiz and qualified for the mega final round to be held in Mumbai.

Comprising of five rounds - flip-boarding, dronning, @tcs, disruptive thinking and so-lo-mo (social, local, mobile); the children were puzzled over technology-based questions throughout. These rounds included buzzer, direct questions, audio-visual, etc.

During the quiz, the quizmaster kept the audience entertained by putting across tech-based questions to them as well.

A twitter contest too was organised by the TCS team, where the audience was asked to do the highest number of tweets.
