TCS IT WIZ 2014 IN MUMBAI

Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) announced that the Mumbai edition of TCS IT Wiz 2014 will be held on Sunday, November 16, at the Indian Education Society.

Students studying in Classes 8 – 12 can participate. There is no entry fee. Each institution is allowed to send 10 teams of two-members each to participate.

TCS IT Wiz 2014 is held across 14 locations in India - Ahmedabad, Bangalore, Bhubaneswar, Chennai, Coimbatore, Delhi, Hyderabad, Indore, Kochi, Kolkata, Lucknow, Mumbai, Nagpur and Pune.

Entries have to be sent through the respective institutions on or before November 14.

Quiz format

The top six teams from the written prelim will qualify for the regional finals. Only the top scoring team from each school will be called on stage in the event of multiple teams from the same school qualify. The winner from the regionals will contest in the mega finals along with the UAE team, to be held in December.

Tweet and earn mileage

The regional finals will have a Twitter contest for all the participants and the top two winners will receive Bluetooth speakers. The twitter contest will also involve a mileage earning system where every tweet will earn a point, tweet with picture three points and retweets will fetch 5 points. The student with highest tweet point across the 14 cities will win a trip to Mumbai to witness Mega finals of TCS IT Wiz.

Three questions will appear on the screen and students can tweet their answers to the handle @TCStweetwiz during the correction break and the top three on first-come-first basis along with all correct answers will receive themselves a boom headphone each.

It will also focus on emerging areas such as cloud computing, telecom, biometrics, robotics, world of Internet, unique web sites, IT buzzwords and acronyms.
