**FOUR ROUNDS**

There were four rounds at the quiz: Flip-boarding, Droning, Disruptor and Social-Local-Mobile. In Flip-boarding, the teams were given a choice to answer the direct question or flip the same for an easier question, but with a lower value. The Droning round comprised a set of countries and the team would get an IT-related question from the country they chose. The Social-Local-Mobile round had teams getting a question each from social, local and mobile aspects.

quiz software was used for the contest, with a unique format created by quiz-master Giri Balasubramaniam and his team.

Speaking to Sakal Times, Balasubramaniam said, "We asked tougher questions during our Pune round as the competition is at a much higher level compared to other cities."
