Format: The top six teams from the written preliminary round will qualify for the regionals finals. Only the top scoring team from each school will be called on stage in the event of multiple teams from the same school qualify for the final. The winning team from the regional finals will contest in the in the mega finals that will be held during December in Mumbai. The winning team along with an escort will be flown to Mumbai.
