

IT Wiz Sacred Heart emerges winner, St Paul finishes second

Winners to represent city at National finals in Mumbai

Sacred Heart School (Kota) emerged winner and St Paul School (Indore) runner-up of Indore edition of IT Wiz, one of the country's biggest inter-school quiz contest, organised by Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) at Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya (DAVV) auditorium on Tuesday.

The winners will represent the city at National finals to be held in Mumbai.

The quiz, which was for students of Class VIII to XII, witnessed participation of schools from Bhopal, Kota and Varanasi. Each institution had sent a maximum of eight teams with each team consisting of two members.

The IT quiz contest, which was kept free for participation, focused on four areas- Automation, Contextual Knowledge, Machine Learning, and Agile.

The top six teams from the written preliminary round were qualified for the regional finals.

After five rounds of

quizzing at the regional finals, the Sacred Heart School team consisting Animesh Harsh and Shresth Pal was declared the winner while Kartik Tiwari and Rudaraksh Tripathi from St Paul School emerged as the runner-up team.

The regional champions walked away with Rs

60,000 gift vouchers while the runners-up received gift vouchers worth Rs 40,000.

The IT Wiz 2017 is being held across 12 cities across India - Ahmedabad, Bengaluru, Chennai, Hyderabad, Kolkata, Indore, Nagpur, Bhubaneswar, Kochi, Delhi, Mumbai and Pune.
