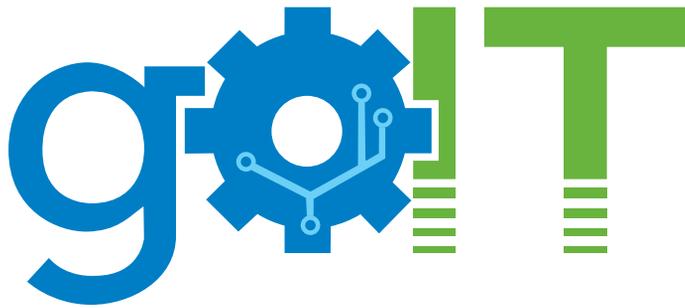


# goIT - Student Technology Awareness Program

Working in a team environment, students tackle project-based challenges, learn icon-based programming languages, and acquire critical-thinking and problem-solving skills.

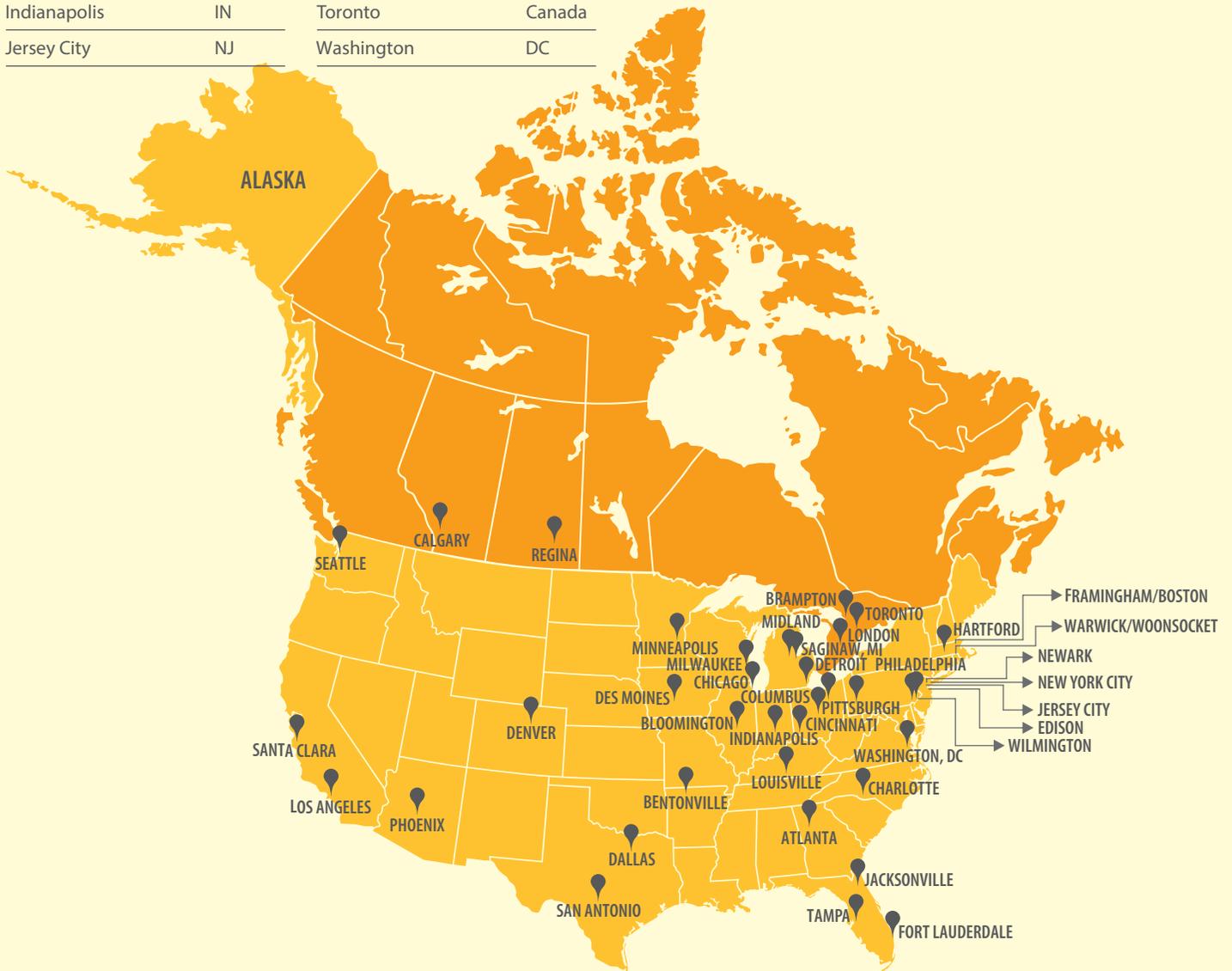
